You'll have previous experience of exhibition installation, perhaps in a museum, gallery or similar work environment. As a hands-on carpenter, you'll enjoy flexing your practical problem solving skills. You'll be confident working with both hand and power tools and will be happy to work at height if required. As a team-player you'll enjoy working with the wider team towards common goals and deadlines. And you'll take pride in seeing a good job well done!

This position is offered on a fixed term basis, running for 6 months. Working hours are dependent on business needs. Whilst working an average of 80 hours over the month, you would be required to work more hours during busy weeks and less during quieter spells.
