KS1

Creature Features—An introduction to animal classification. Get up close to and touch our real specimens to compare their main features. Discover the differences between herbivores, carnivores and omnivores.

Dinosaurs and Beyond— Discover who met a dinosaur, how we know dinosaurs existed, and which animal group they belong to. Explore our fossil collection and discover how fossils are formed.

Staying Alive— Investigate what all animals need to survive as well as the need to stay healthy. Discover how animals grow and change, including the importance of reproduction.



KS2

Skeletons and Movement— Complete the build a skeleton challenge to discover all about joints, movement and support. Create a healthy plate and find out about different animal diets.

Teeth and Eating—Compare the teeth of carnivores, herbivores, and omnivores to identify the different types of teeth. Discover the functions of the organs in the digestive system. Use our specimens to create a food chain identifying producers, predators, and prey.

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
