Explore Darwin's big ideas through hands-on activities with real specimens. Children can investigate how evolution through natural selection works by observing finches' beaks and experimenting with camouflage. They explore the branches and dead ends on a tree of life with a wealth of specimens from fossils to stuffed mammals, become 19th century scientists studying Darwin's animals for their adaptations and put together Darwin's life story to present through role play in his parlour. All in a 2 hour workshop led by expert staff.



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
