



## Changes in Britain from Stone Age to the Iron Age

### Stone, Bronze, Iron - Make a Pre-history Museum

#### A great introduction to pre-history for children

Your class take on the role of being archaeologists and uncover real Stone, Bronze, and Iron Age finds in our mini class dig. They then become Museum Curators focusing on one era in pre-history and focus on one object to catalogue in the mini museum. Next they have the challenge of being an Exhibition Officer and work as a team to create a pre-history museum with the real artefacts. The workshop ends with them becoming museum visitors and having a go at a range of hands-on activities including dressing up, wheat grinding, weaving, and making a bracelet.



### Of Mammoths and Men

#### Could your class have survived the Stone Age?

This workshop sets the challenge to determine just that. Your children will be taken back in time to the Stone Age and work in Tribes to complete many different challenges using their enquiry skills, knowledge, and understanding of what it would have been like to have lived during that time. From a Stone Age Bush Tucker Trial to working out which materials would have been available to make homes, tools, and clothing, there are lots of hands-on team challenges to give your class a real insight into the lives of these people.



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
