



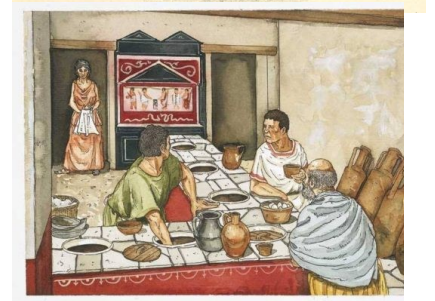
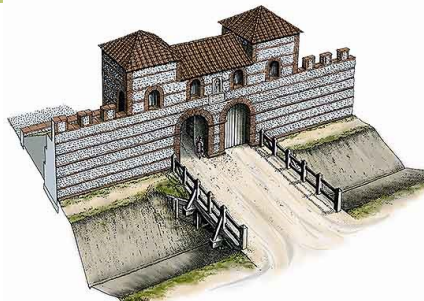
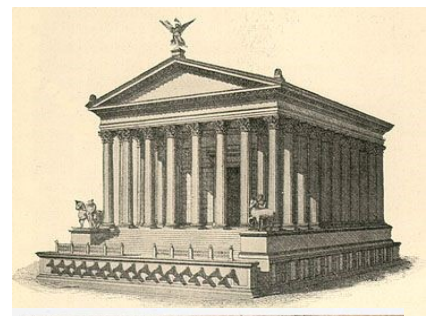
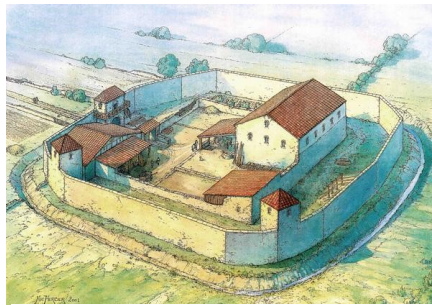
The Roman Empire and its Impact on Britain

Archaeology in Action - The Romans

Bring your class to **SEARCH** to be Archaeologists and solve a real archaeological problem.

Was it a fort, farm, inn, or temple? Your class decides after taking on the role of being archaeologists exploring real evidence, thinking critically, weighing up the possibilities, and constructing an argument. Using real Roman artefacts children have the opportunity to discover more about Romans and the impact they had on Britain just as an archaeologist does.

They will identify Roman animal bones to discover which animals were at this site, sift through soil samples and use a video microscope to identify the smallest clues left behind, put a pot back together, create a mosaic, work out who is the soldier in the grave, and handle real special finds to bring learning to life.
