At ten years old, Fanny Price is sent to live in the household of her wealthy relations.



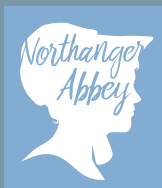
Emma

The last fully completed novel by Jane Austen tells the story of a second chance of lost love.

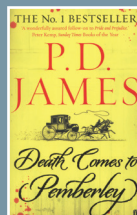
